The racial justice work of Alaska Friends Conference has recently focused on dialogue between Native Americans and Alaskans of European descent. AFC recently concluded the Subsistence Project in conjunction with American Friends Service Committee (AFSC). The project was intended to help address the ongoing tensions between rural residents in Alaska, mostly Native Americans, who hunt and fish for their subsistence, and urban sport hunters and commercial fishermen, who are mostly non-Native American. Many of the interviews were recorded and compiled onto audio CDs.
